RE: Downgrade of 439 Water Supply Corp. Drought Warning to a stage 1 Drought Watch Condition.

439 Water Supply Members:

In accordance with our Drought Contingency plan, 439 Water Supply Corp. issued a Stage 2 Drought condition on August 9, 2023. Due to recent rainfall, we are terminating the Stage 2 Drought Warning for all members of 439 Water Supply Corp. Therefore 439 Water Supply Corp. will be downgrading to a Stage 1 Drought Watch condition effective immediately.

Stage 1 Response - MILD Water Shortage Conditions

Goal: Achieve a voluntary 5% reduction in total water use.

Voluntary Water Use Restrictions

- A) Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to Sundays and Thursdays for customers with a street address ending in an even number (0,2,4,6, or 8), and Saturdays and Wednesdays for water customers with a street address ending in an odd number (1,3,5,7, or 9) and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of midnight and 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight on designated watering days.
- B) All operations of the 439 Water Supply Corp. shall adhere to water use restrictions prescribed for Stage 1 of the plan.
- C) Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.
